NaturArchy is an exhibition resulting from two years of deep collaboration and co-creation between artists, scientists and policymakers on issues of deep ecology, sustainability and the decolonisation of nature. 16 works of art respond to the provocative call of re-imagining the relationship between human and nonhuman, in an attempt to re-frame views on the natural world and sense the deep entanglement of earth systems and human systems.

Join us for final reflections upon this journey and questions of what is next for the rights of nature? What is the role of arts and curation for this movement? How can local communities get involved? How can artists fit within the science-policy ecosystem?
